Instructions to Trailer Drivers and people with Own Boats

Thursday 1st September

14:00 – 16:00 Deliver boats to Leeds Rowing Club Stourton Boathouse, Thwaite Lane, Leeds, LS10 1RN.
Please note this is Leeds RC's new site, so do not go to the old site as shown on their website.

If there is insufficient space on the club site, we may leave some boats on the Sea Cadets site next door.

Take trailers to Pastures Inn, Pastures Road, Mexborough, S64 0JJ.

The quickest route is via the M62, A1(M) and A635.

Note – if you are using satellite navigation, it may try to take you down a track which is a dead end, so follow Pastures Road until you see the hotel sign.

Park in the marked area to the right of the hotel entrance

Sunday 4th September

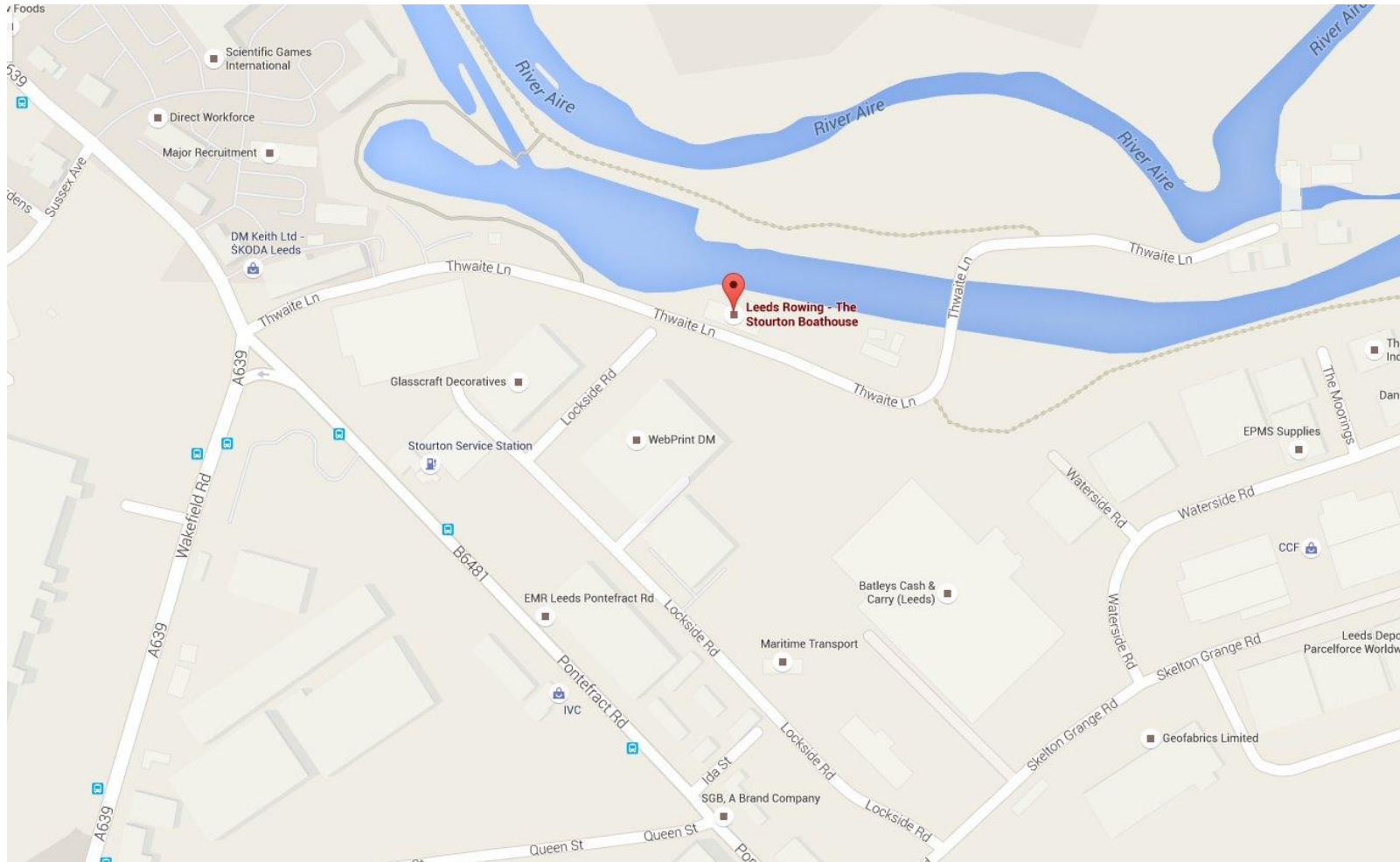
Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and accompany the rest of the group on the bus.

Leeds Rowing Club new site LS10 1RN



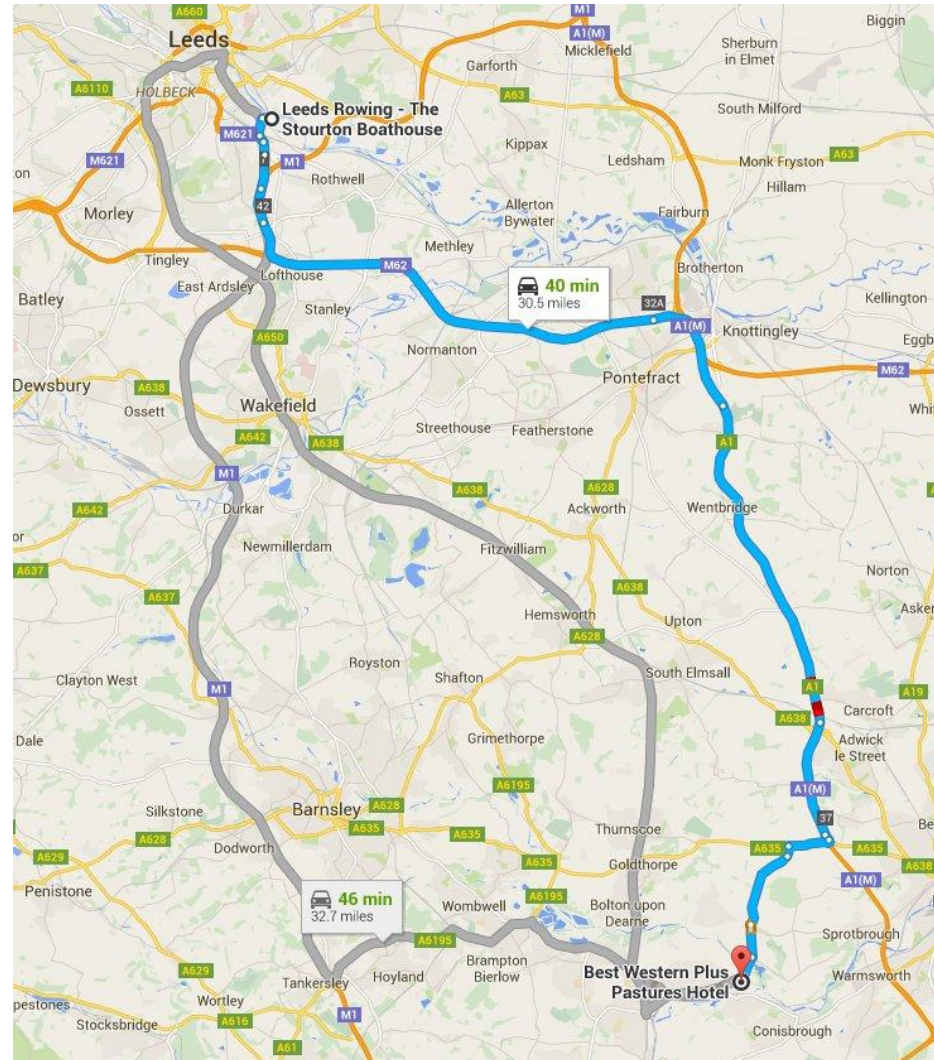


Pastures Hotel, Mexborough S64 0JJ
